



Greetings from the York Academy:

Traffic Flow and Parking Concerns

Please be advised that parking or stopping at any time between the signed labeled for bus drop-off will result in a ticket being issued by the City of York. It is imperative that this area remain empty during arrival and dismissal of school. There are thirty buses/vans that service our school and when the designated area is filled with parked cars, it creates a traffic problem through the City of York.



The number of cars dropping off students in this bus lane has caused a traffic problem on Beaver Street. It is important that the 30 buses/vans have easy access to this drop-off point and do not sit on Beaver Street waiting for cars to move from this location.

City officials provided York Academy families with a parking lot on the west side of Beaver Street that is to be used for all parking during drop-off and pick-up of children. Please use the designated areas for parking.

Once again, do not use the east or west side of Beaver Street to drop off or pick up students attending the York Academy.



Cherry Lane

Be reminded that Cherry Lane is posted as "No Parking" on either side of the lane. As a reminder to our parents, please do not park in Cherry Lane while waiting for children.

LCS Design (now Warehaus) Parking Lot

There are a number of families that are parking in the LCS Design lot during dismissal. Please understand that this is a private parking lot and York Academy families are not permitted to park in that lot. The owners of the architectural firm will be meeting with school officials to develop a plan to eliminate parent's use of the lot.



Understand that when a large number of cars are parked in that lot, there are no spaces for the clients of the firm. Please do not use this parking lot. Please be reminded that in addition to the lot on Beaver Street, Small's Field is available for parent parking.

Crossing North Street



All students from grades five through eight exit the building on North Street. All students and parents are to use the intersection at North and Beaver Streets to cross North Street. Please be reminded that a York Academy student was hit by a car last year as they attempted to cross the street in the middle of the block.

All of us realize that traffic on Beaver and North Streets is heavy at arrival and dismissal. It is important for everyone to be cautious and safely cross at the intersection.
